

## Guest Policy

Your complimentary guest passes will be available at the pool after opening day. All guests MUST be registered and accompanied by a member upon entering the pool facility. After these passes are used up, additional guests may be brought with you for \$8.00 per person.

## Inclement Weather Policy

*Temperature:* The pool will not open in the event the air temperature is not above 65 degrees F.

*Thunder:* In the presence of thunder, the pool and surrounding areas will be cleared for 15 minutes. No one will be allowed in/near the pool or hot tub areas.

*Lightning:* In the case where lightning is sighted, the pool and surrounding area will be cleared for 30 minutes. No one will be allowed in/near the pool and hot tub areas.

In the case where a storm does not clear up, the manager on duty may close the pool for the afternoon or evening. If a storm moves in during the morning hours, the pool will attempt to reopen that afternoon weather permitting, whereas if a storm moves in during the evening hours, the pool will close early for the day.

## **Food**

Food is allowed in the pool area. Eating areas are limited to the Veranda, next to the Cabana, and in the Picnic Pavilion. One grill is located next to the Cabana for your convenience.

To help maintain this beautiful facility, we ask that each member pick up after him/herself. This facility can only stay in tip-top shape with your help.

Food items such as chips, cookies and crackers will attract ants; PLEASE do not use these items next to the lounge chairs.

**NO GLASS FOOD OR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS**  
are allowed on/near the pool deck.  
Please keep food in designated areas.

## **Gum**

Gum is discouraged as it can lead to choking and could desecrate the pool deck.

## **Alcohol Policy**

Alcohol is permitted on the veranda and cabana areas.

## **Tobacco Policy**

Tobacco in any form is NOT permitted in the clubhouse or pool facility.

## **Pool Rules**

No running, pushing, or horseplay

No offensive language

No glass containers

Food permitted only on veranda or cabana areas

Flotation devices permitted at the discretion of Lifeguards

Diving allowed only in deep end as marked

Adults (18 or older) may swim during breaks

Children under 11 must be accompanied to the pool by a responsible person 16 or older

For safety, diaper age children must wear plastic pants or swim diapers

# Hot Tub Rules

## CAUTION

- Pregnant women, elderly persons suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high or low blood pressure should not enter the hot tub without prior medical consultation and permission from their doctor.
- Do not use the hot tub while under the influence of alcohol, tranquilizers, or other drugs that cause drowsiness or that raise or lower blood pressure.
- Observe reasonable time limits (that is, ten to fifteen minutes), then leave the water and cool down before returning for another brief stay.
- Do not use at water temperatures greater than one hundred four degrees Fahrenheit.
- Long exposure may result in nausea, dizziness, or fainting.
- Children under the age of 15 must be supervised.
- Do not use alone.

# Water Slide Rules

Deep Water

Life jackets or other  
flotation devices are prohibited

Users must exit the landing area  
immediately

You must be able to exit catch pool unassisted

Users in line for the slide shall follow directions from the Lifeguard on duty

Users shall ride feet first at all times

Stopping, changing position,  
and forming "chains" of  
2 or more people are  
prohibited

## **Tennis and Basketball Courts**

Animals, pets, bikes, roller blades, skateboard, and motorized vehicles are not permitted on the tennis or basketball courts at any time. Only people playing are permitted on the courts.

### **Guests**
